

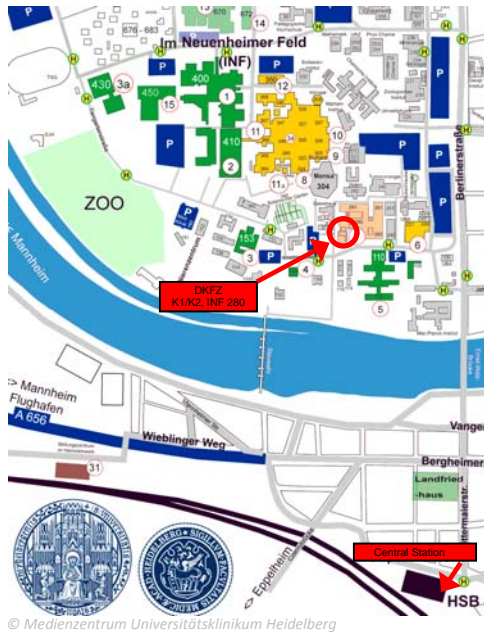
## How to get there

**By public transport:** *Tram:* No 24 direction "Handschuhsheim/Burgstr.", or No 21 direction "OEG-Bahnhof". Exit station "Jahnstraße" and follow the signs about 200m.

*Bus:* No 32 to "Sportzentrum Nord", get off at "Chirurgische Klinik". Follow the road about 100m; DKFZ to your right.

**By car:** A5 from Frankfurt or Karlsruhe, change to A656 at "Heidelberger Kreuz". Follow the signs „Eberbach/HD-Wieblingen/Chirurgie“, then "Chirurgie/DKFZ". Charged parking lots are available as highlighted in the map.

**By plane:** On arrival at Frankfurt Intl. Airport, take the train to Heidelberg Central Station. Frankfurt Hahn Airport is located about 150 km away. Shuttle busses are available ([www.hahn-express.de](http://www.hahn-express.de))
